**Complete APRN certification program** (generally 1 year); earn one of the following:

- CNP: Certified Nurse Practitioner
- CNS: Clinical Nurse Specialist
- CNM: Certified Nurse Midwife
- \*CRNA: Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist
  - Beginning 2022, a Doctorate (DNP) will be required before completing this specialty
